## FASN Annual Conference 2010: "School Nurses: Going the Extra Mile"

The 15<sup>th</sup> Annual Florida School Nurses Conference will be held at the Orlando Marriott Lake Mary in the center of Florida's High Tech Corridor. This year's conference will enable school nurses to obtain knowledge and skills in current issues that are impacting school nursing practice. Our conference presenters are recognized specialists in their respective fields.
